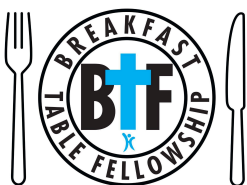
**Youth at Huron Chapel:** Fri. Jan. 31, 7 p.m.- 10 p.m. Please bring your bibles and money for the snack shack.
